An Act relative to transport under Section 12(a).

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 (a) of Chapter 123 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the second sentence by striking out in line 14 the word
- 3 “and” and inserting therein the word “or”.
