**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act providing equitable access to behavioral health services for MassHealth consumers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the ninth paragraph the following  
3 sentence:-

4 The Division shall ensure that all contracted health insurers, health plans, health maintenance  
5 organizations, and behavioral health management firms and third party administrators provide  
6 comparable access to behavioral health services, benefits, and medications in providing medical  
7 assistance to recipients.

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
