Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1: The General Laws are hereby amended in Section 13C of chapter 118E by
- 2 inserting after the last paragraph the following paragraph:-
- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Secretary of Health and
- 4 Human Services shall not set the rate for adult residential behavioral health and addiction
- 5 treatment lower than \$125 a day.
