Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1.	Chapter 118E of	the General Laws	, as appearing in	the 2012 Official
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2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 10G the following new section:-

3 "Section 10 H. The division shall provide coverage for the administration of all Food

4 and Drug Administration approved drugs for the treatment of opioid dependence and shall

5 establish billing codes and rates of payment for licensed methadone clinics to provide services to

6 eligible individuals needing treatment for opioid dependence."
