### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act improving public health through immunizations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION1. Section 24M of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, "and (5) staff of state agencies or state programs
- 3 whose duties include education and outreach related to the improvement of immunization
- 4 coverage rates among their clients" and replacing it with "(5) staff of state agencies or state
- 5 programs whose duties include education and outreach related to the improvement of
- 6 immunization coverage rates among their clients; and (6) health plans for immunization rate
- 7 improvement and quality improvement efforts."
