### AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE TERM EMPLOYEES FOR LABOR RELATIONS PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 150A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word “orders” in line 24 the following:-  
3       provided, however employees of secondary schools operated by religious societies that are not connected with or  
4 controlled by any local diocese, parish, church, synagogue or similar religious organization shall be employees
