### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to responsible drivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the word "curriculum" in line 67 the following language:-
- In addition to classroom and road training, a student shall complete a supervised
- 4 defensive driving course, a form of training for motor vehicle drivers that goes beyond mastery
- 5 of the rules of the road and the basic mechanics of driving with an aim to reduce the risk of
- 6 collision by anticipating dangerous situations, despite adverse conditions or the mistakes of
- others. The course must comply with ANSI/ASSE Z15.1 and be approved by the Registry of
- 8 Motor Vehicles.
