Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 13I of Chapter 265 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the words "treating or transporting
- a person".
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 13I of Chapter 265 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2018
- 5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 5 and 6, the words "house of
- 6 correction for not less than 90 days nor more than 2 and one-half years or by a fine of not less
- 7 than \$500 nor more than \$5,000, or both." and inserting in place thereof the following words:
- 8 "state prison for not more than five years, or by imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for
- 9 not more than two and one-half years."
