The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act granting equal access to original birth certificates to all persons born in Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2B of chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, the words "on or before July
- 3 17, 1974 or on or after January 1, 2008".
- 4 SECTION 2. Said section 2B of chapter 46, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 5 by striking out, in line 6, the words "on or after January 1, 2008".
