An Act relative to workers' compensation disfigurement benefits concerning scarring.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 36 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out the words “or hands”, in line 82, and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following words:- ,distally to the elbows, or distally to the knees.
