- 3 SECTION 1. Chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 4 hereby amended in section 1 by adding at the end thereof the following:
- 5 Every citizen seventeen years of age or older who is a resident in the city or town where he or
- 6 she claims the right to vote at the time he or she registers, and who has complied with the
- 7 requirements of this chapter, may have his or her name entered on the list of voters in such city
- 8 or town, and may vote therein in any election for officers in such city or town.
