In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to charter school renewal .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (kk) of Section 89 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended in Section 51 Chapter 131 of the Acts of 2010, is hereby amended by inserting in the
3 first sentence after the word, “charter”, the following: -; provided, however, that the term for a
4 charter school renewal shall be 7 years from the expiration of the initial charter or subsequent
5 renewals.
