Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 21A of chapter 118E is amended by deleting the current 1 subsection and substituting the following new subsection:-

(c) In making determinations under this section, the division shall revise the community spouse 3 4 resource allowance as permitted or required by federal law. Either spouse shall have the right to 5 request a fair hearing at which, if it is shown that the income of the community spouse is less than the minimum monthly maintenance needs allowance of the community spouse, the referee 6 shall revise the community spouse resource allowance, using methods permitted or required by 7 8 federal law, to a level sufficient to generate the shortfall in income. The division shall calculate

- 9 interest income on the investment of the community spouse resource allowance using the
- 10 average money market rates reported by Bank Rate Inc. on the date of the hearing.
