## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to cueing and supervision in the PCA program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 4. Section 12 of chapter one hundred and eighteen E as so appearing, is hereby

2 amended in the first paragraph by inserting at the end thereof the following new sentence:-

3 "Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
4 division shall develop or amend any standards and regulations applicable to the personal care
5 attendant program to include as eligible members those individuals who are otherwise eligible
6 for said program, but who require supervision and cueing in order to perform two or more
7 activities of daily living."
