### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to pre-registration of voters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 47A of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following: A person who is otherwise
- 3 qualified may pre-register on or after that person's sixteen birthday and may vote in any election
- 4 occurring on or after that person's eighteenth birthday.
