An Act relative to HLTV 111 tests.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 70F of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- Notwithstanding the above, if the person's blood has come in contact with another person
- 4 who may be infected thereby, such tests shall be performed and the result made known to the
- 5 person who may have been infected despite the inability or refusal of the person to give written
- 6 consent.
