An Act relative to physician assistants and interscholastic athletic head injuries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 222 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word  
3 "physicians", in line 7, the following words:- “, physician assistants”

5   SECTION 2. Section 222 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is further  
6 amended in subsection (c) by inserting after the word "neuropsychologist", in line 39 and in line  
7 50, the following words:- "physician assistant,".
