In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the recorking of wine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 33 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended by inserting, at the end of the paragraph, the following:- and provided further, that the limitations 2 relative to service and consumption in a tavern, club or war veterans organization licensed 3 4 pursuant to this section shall not be deemed to preclude the holder of the tavern, club or war veterans license from allowing a patron, member or guest, as the case may be, to retain and take 5 off the premises only so much as may remain of a bottled wine purchased by the said patron, 6 7 member or guest in conjunction with a meal and not totally consumed by said patron, member or guest during such meal; provided further, that the bottle shall be resealed in accordance with 8 regulations promulgated by the commission. 9
