Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 47 of Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of said section the following
- 3 sentence:- "The examination shall not require the performance of any irreversible procedure
- 4 upon a live patient."
