An Act relative to the STEM advisory council.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 217 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as amended by Section 12 of  
2 Chapter 165 of the Acts of 2014, is hereby amended in subsection (c) by striking out the word  
3 “30” in the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following word:- 35.

4           SECTION 2. Said section 217 is hereby further amended in subsection (c) by inserting  
5 after the words “not-for-profit organization” the following words:- ; provided further, that not  
6 fewer than 12 members of the Council shall represent companies that employ STEM  
7 professionals.
