In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act to implement full-day kindergarten.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1B of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 121-124, inclusive, the twenty-
- 3 second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-
- 4 "The board shall establish the permissible and mandatory ages for school attendance
- 5 provided that each child be required to attend a full-day educational program at kindergarten
- 6 age.".
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 8 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "education", in line 2, the
- 9 following words:-
- "and any child enrolled in full-day kindergarten".
