## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to insurance coverage for homeowner heating safety and remediation of oil spills.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of Section 4D of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “occurrence” in line 14,  
3 the following words: - or the policy’s personal liability limit, whichever is greater

4 SECTION 2. Paragraph (b) of Section 4D of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as so appearing,  
5 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word “applicable” in line 28, the following  
6 sentence:- No insurers shall be allowed to exclude said first-party and third-party liability  
7 coverage arising out of the release of heating oil under the liability coverage provisions of a  
8 homeowner’s insurance policy.
