An Act relative to insurance surcharges.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 113B of chapter 175 of the
- 2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, and most recently amended by chapter
- 3 155 of the Acts of 2009, is hereby amended by inserting in line 221, after the word “incident.”,
- 4 the following sentence:- “Driving a motor vehicle that has an expired inspection sticker shall not
- 5 be considered a surchargeable incident.”
