**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act promoting a foundation for universal childcare.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 40A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the fifth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the
3 following paragraph:-

4 Family child care home and large family child care home, as defined in section 1A of
5 chapter 15D, shall be an allowable use and no city or town shall prohibit or regulate such use in a
6 private residence in its zoning ordinances or by-laws.
