Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 53 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 39, of subsection (c) by inserting after the word
- 3 "section." the following:-
- 4 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the commissioner of public
- 5 safety shall not promulgate any rules or regulations requiring more than two hours of classroom
- 6 credit every four years for renewal of a hoisting license.
