Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 2 of chapter 111M of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "July 1, 2007," and
- 3 inserting in place thereof:- "January 1, 2014."
- 4 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the current minimum
- 5 creditable coverage regulations, promulgated under said section 2 of chapter 111M of the
- 6 General Laws, shall be suspended until January 1, 2014.
