In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act to increase voter registration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section
- 2 63 the following section:-
- 3 Section 64. The Massachusetts Department of Revenue shall be directed to use its offices
- 4 and personnel to register new voters with means, mailings, methods, presence, forms, outreach,
- 5 and publications that are at least as complete and encompassing as those used by any other state
- 6 agency or department, which does not have as its primary purpose voter registration.
