An Act reducing prescription drug abuse.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 22 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 3 Section 22. Prescription Drug Drop-off Box Grant Program
- 4 The department of public safety shall establish a grant program, subject to appropriation,
- 5 to be known as the prescription drug drop-off box grant program, for the purpose of providing
- 6 grants to assist police departments with the purchase, placement, operation, or maintenance of
- 7 prescription drug drop-off boxes at police stations.
- 8 The department of public safety shall establish guidelines governing the prescription drug
- 9 drop-off box grant program.
