AN ACT REGARDING MASSHEALTH APPLICATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Section 9 of chapter 118e of the general laws, as amended by chapter 211 of the acts of 2006, is 1 2 hereby amended by inserting, after the words "long-term care needs of the individuals," the following:-3 The division shall provide, without requiring prior authorization, for up to sixty (60) days of eligibility for 4 masshealth home and community based services, including personal care services, for individuals who, upon 5 6 discharge from an acute hospital, medical center, nursing facility, or health care facility including rehabilitation facilities and state hospitals, are presumed to be financially eligible for the masshealth program and 7 clinically eligible for home and community based services, as determined by an aging services access point or 8 an independent living center; provided further the division shall promulgate such standards and regulations 9 as may be necessary for the administration of said presumptive eligibility program.
