The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act regulating residential paving.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 142A of the general laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the definition "residential contracting" and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following definition:-

5 "Residential Contracting", the reconstruction, alteration, renovation, repair,

- 6 modernization, conversion, improvement, removal, or demolition, or the construction of an
- 7 addition to any pre-existing owner occupied building containing at least one but not more than
- 8 four dwelling units, which building or portion thereof is used or designed to be used as a
- 9 residence or dwelling unit, to structures which are adjacent to such residence or building or the

- 10 application of any paving material, including but not limited to oil based paving and sealing
- 11 materials, on a ground surface of the property of such residence from or adjacent to an area
- 12 accessible to the property from a public or private way.
- SECTION 2. Section 14 of chapter 142A of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 14 amended by striking out, in line 43, the words "; or asphalt and driveway installation and
- 15 maintenance."
