RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO STUDY AND RECOMMEND
IMPROVEMENTS IN THE DELIVERY OF PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFITS FOR THE CITIZENS
OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 There is hereby established a special commission to study the delivery of prescription
2 drug benefits in the Commonwealth. The Commission shall study and analyze bulk purchasing,
3 discount cards, private section insurance drug programs, pharmaceutical benefit managers, and
4 other issues which may improve prescription drug benefits for the citizens of the
5 Commonwealth.
