In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to lottery ticket litter reduction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 165 of the acts of 2014 is hereby amended by inserting in section 2,
- 2 in item 0640-0010, the following clause:-
- 3 ; and provided further, that not less than 20 per cent of the amount appropriated in this
- 4 item shall be expended by the state treasurer for the creation, implementation, and marketing of a
- 5 "second chance lottery program" to encourage the recycling of lottery tickets to reduce waste and
- 6 litter.
