# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to captains of the Massachusetts Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the

2 contrary, the Massachusetts department of corrections will allow any employee of the rank of

3 captain to convert and recode via payroll/comptroller/state board of retirement, any

4 compensatory time or pay into holiday pay for the purposes of calculating salary for retirement

5 purposes.

7 SECTION 2 The provisions of section 1 shall only apply to the time period from
8 August 2009 to June 2012.

9 SECTION 3 The provisions of this bill will expire on January 1, 2017 for any

10 individual eligible for this conversion as provided for in section 1 and section 2.
