AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEES FOR THE RENEWAL OF FIREARM IDENTIFICATION CARDS
BY CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 129B of Chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking out paragraph 10 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
3 (10) Any person who is over the age of 70 during the term of the firearm identification card shall be
4 exempt from the requirement of paying a renewal fee.
