In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to moving vehicle violations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1
- 2 Notwithstanding any general or special law or any rule or regulation to the contrary,
- 3 violation of section 7A or section 7V of Chapter 90 of the General Laws shall not in any manner
- 4 implicate the motor vehicle insurance rate of such alleged violator.
- 5 Section 2
- 6 This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
