**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to the Ware Selectboard.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 ARTICLE 25. Passed by a Majority vote in favor that the Town authorize the Board of
2 Selectmen to petition the legislature for a special act of legislation “Notwithstanding any general
3 or special law or charter provision or bylaw or regulation to the contrary, the executive body of
4 the Town of Ware, previously known as the Board of Selectmen, shall henceforth be known as
5 the Selectboard and shall have all of the powers, duties, responsibilities and authority of
6 “selectmen” or “board of selectmen” under any federal law or regulation and under any general
7 or special Massachusetts law or regulation and under any charter provisions or bylaws or
8 regulations of the Town of Ware; provided, that the legislature may reasonably change the form
9 and substance of the requested legislation with the scope of the general public objectives of this
10 petition.”
