Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26C of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
- 2 chapter 267 of the Acts of 2010, is hereby amended, in line 2, by inserting after the word "invite"
- 3 the following words:-- by any means, including but not limited to: personal contact, postal mail,
- 4 telephone, instant electronic messaging and electronic mail.
