Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 Chapter 32 Section 94B(2) of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition is
- 3 hereby amended by striking the word five in line 27 and insert the word ten after the word within
- 4 in line 27.
- 5 Section 2. Chapter 32 Section 94B (2) of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014
- 6 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 31 after the word compensation the
- 7 following words, in the event that such person retires in accordance with this section any
- 8 secondary cancer shall be covered in accordance with section 9 of this chapter.
