**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to post-retirement earnings of public retirees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 97 the words
3 “nine hundred and sixty” and inserting in place thereof the following words:-
4 “one thousand two hundred.”
