## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the definition of Group 4 of the retirement system.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: The definition of Group 4, as set forth in chapter 32, section 3, paragraph

- 2 (2), subparagraph (g) is hereby amended by adding thereto the words: employees of the
- 3 Commonwealth who are employed as steam fireman/co-generation, third class engineer/co-
- 4 generation, second class engineer/co-generation, first class engineer/co-generation and chief
- 5 engineer/co-generation.
