### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to in-state tuition retention for UMMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 1A the

2 following:

3 Section 1B: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the University of

4 Massachusetts Medical School shall retain all in-state tuition and mandatory general attendance

5 fees charged to students, provided that general attendance fees shall not include charges for

6 health insurance.
