*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

Section 9B of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012

Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 9 and 10, the words “the entire cost

of such premium without any contribution by the governmental unit” and inserting in place

5

thereof the following words: - one-half the cost of such premiums with one-half the cost of such

premiums paid by the governmental unit.

SECTION 2. Section 9D of said chapter 32B is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Section 11 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012

Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 6 the words "until the remarriage of

said surviving spouse".

11           SECTION 4. Section 9B of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
12 amended by striking out in lines 4 and 5 the words ",until the remarriage or death of said  
13 surviving spouse".

14           SECTION 5. The provisions in sections 3 and 4 of this act shall apply to surviving  
15 spouses of a deceased employee or retired employee, who remarried prior to the effective date of  
16 this act and whose insurance coverage, upon remarriage, was terminated under chapters 32A or  
17 32B of the General Laws.

18           SECTION 6. The provisions in sections 3, 4 and 5 of this act shall be prospective from  
19 the effective date of this act and shall not entitle any surviving spouse of a deceased employee or  
20 retired employee to any retroactive insurance coverage.
