An Act to promote local agriculture and student nutrition.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 223 of Chapter 111 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended in  
2 paragraph (f) thereof by adding the following after the phrase “district-wide wellness policies  
3 addressing school nutrition, nutrition education and physical activity”:

4           “, and school gardens. The regulations may further require coordinating support for  
5 school gardens with professional agricultural and horticulture associations.”
