Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 151 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 6 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in the second sentence, the words "\$8.00 per hour"
- 7 and inserting in place thereof the following words:-
- 8 \$8.75 per hour as of July 1, 2011, \$9.50 per hour as of July 1, 2012 and \$10.00 per hour as of
- 9 July 1, 2013

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- 10 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 151, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
- 11 after the second sentence the following new sentences:-
- 12 Beginning in 2014, and in each year thereafter, the minimum wage shall be adjusted based upon
- 13 the twelve-month percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban
- 14 Consumers (or a successor index, if any) as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the
- 15 United States Department of Labor, based on the most recent twelve-month period for which
- data is available at the time that the adjustment is made, and rounded to the nearest five cents.
- 17 The adjusted minimum wage shall be calculated and announced by April 1 of each year, and
- 18 shall become effective as the new minimum wage on July 1 of each year.
- 19 SECTION 3. Said section 1 of said chapter 151, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 20 striking out, in the last sentence, the word "\$.10" and inserting in place thereof the following
- 21 words:-
- 22 \$1.50
- 23 SECTION 4. Section 7 of said chapter 151, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out,
- 24 in the third paragraph, the words "the cash wage required to be paid such an employee on July 1,
- 25 1999" and inserting in place thereof:-
- 26 70 percent of the wage in effect under section 1 of this chapter
- 27 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on upon enactment.
