An Act relative to disability retirement benefits for veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 157 section 2 of the Acts of 2005 shall be amended by striking out  
2 the following- “No payment shall be made under this act with respect to a person who is  
3 deceased” and adding the following sentence- “In the case of a veteran being deceased a  
4 payment under this section shall be made in a lump sum to a living spouse or a living family  
5 member.”
