An Act relative to unemployment insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, the experience
- 2 rate of an employer qualifying therefor under subsection (b) of said section 14 shall be the rate
- 3 which appears in the column designated "F" in paragraph (1) of subsection (i) of said section 14
- 4 for calendar year 2011.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January 1, 2011.
