**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act to provide certain employees in the department of corrections with line of duty death benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 100A of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws shall be
2 amended by inserting the words "or Unit 8 employees within the Public Safety Secretariat" after
3 the words "or corrections officer" in section (c) line 3, and section (d) line 6, line 7, line 9, line
4 11, and line 12.
