## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to public safety line of duty benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 100A of chapter 32, as appearing in the 2014

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 15, the words "and who is not subject

3 to chapter 152", and inserting at the end of said subsection the following sentence:- "The family

- 4 of a deceased public safety employee, who is subject to chapter 152, shall have the option to
- 5 receive either the killed in the line of duty benefit or to receive benefits pursuant to chapter 152."
