3 Section 111f of chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, in line  
4 19, after the words "General Edward Lawrence Logan International Airport, and for purposes of  
5 this section the Massachusetts Port Authority shall be deemed to be a fire district," the following  
6 words:--; "The provisions of this section shall also apply in all respects to any University of  
7 Massachusetts Police Officer at the Dartmouth campus and any officer with the rank of sergeant  
8 or above at the Amherst campus."
