Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3A of chapter 40A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (a) by adding at the end thereof the following:
- No community without a rail, subway, or ferry station shall have to comply with this
- 4 section.
